ARTIST will be provided with a private dressing area in the event that an on site hotel room is not available. 

PURCHASER AGREES TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING:

Any change to rider requirements must be approved by Artist!

- 1. Power amps must be adequate for size of room and audience, (Crest, Crown or better).
- 2. One professional quality mixing board with <u>minimum</u> of sixteen channels, (Yamaha, Mackie or better).
- 3. Minimum of two professional quality house speakers on stands, (E.V., Meyers, EAW or better). **Ceiling speakers are unacceptable**. Four house speakers if audience is over 300 people, four with subs if over 600 people.
- 4. Two professional quality monitors, (E.V., Meyers, EAW or better).
- 5. Three professional quality microphones (Shure SM58 type or better) on boom stands, (NO GOOSE NECKS, NO SM57s).
- 6. Grand or studio quality Piano, must be tuned to A440 day of show.
- 7. Electronic piano (weighted keys) may be used as a last resort. Suggested electronic pianos: Roland FP1, Korg SG2 sampled grand, Kurtzweil PC 88.
- 8. ARTIST will in most cases provide wireless equipment for vocal and guitar. Receiver will be plugged into the direct box, the other will be plugged into the center stage vocal mic XLR.
- 9. One professional quality reverb unit, (Yamaha SPX 90 or better).
- 10. One professional quality compressor for vocal wireless
- 11. All cords must be tested and in good working order.
- 12. 110 volt, 20 amp quad Edison outlet box on stage one foot from center vocal mic. For quitar effects. A quality plug strip is acceptable.
- 13. One direct box on stage one foot from stage center.
- 14. Stage must be a minimum of 8X8 feet, (12'X16' or larger preferred).
- 15. Stage must be raised and sturdy, 18 inch minimum height.
- 16. Risers (if used) must be skirted and neat.
- 17. A <u>minimum</u> of four par 64 type or Leko lights on each side of stage, (total of eight), see stage plot. Truss lighting with Lekos preferred in larger venues.
- 18. 1 follow spot with dedicated operator required. (small venues optional).
- 19. If light trees are used they must not obstruct view and must be <u>neat!</u>
- 20. 1 quality lighting board required with operator.
- 21. All equipment must be set and tested with sound check by artist at least one hour before room is to be occupied. Allow 30 minutes minimum for sound check.
- 22. Monitor mix must be independent of house mix.
- 23. Reverb must appear in monitors as well as house mix.
- 24.. Sound & lights must be manned and operated by qualified technicians during entire performance. Technicians must be staged at least fifteen minutes prior to show.
- 25. All doors must be closed during performance, house lights dimmed.
- 26. All AC power for sound & lights must be from a dedicated, isolated source. AC for sound system / stage power should be on a different transformer leg than house lighting / stage lighting dimmer system, to prevent 60 cycle hum or ground loops. Power drop if necessary.
